INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cover your work area with newspaper to protect work surface.
2. Collect and place all supplies needed on your work surface.
3. Clean the KraftyBlok™ with glass cleaner or a 50/50 solution of vinegar and water. Dry completely with cloth.
4. Place the KraftyBlok™ in a horizontal position on newspaper with opening at the bottom of project. Remove the silk petals from the plastic stems and centers (stamens).
5. Start at the bottom and working up begin placing glue on the back of a flower. Adhere to the front of the KraftyBlok™. Completely cover the surface with the flowers. Evenly spacing flowers as you go. Continue by gluing ¾" black gems in the center of each flower. Allow the glue to dry completely.
6. Turn the block on its side. Apply adhesive to the back of chips. Place green cathedral chips in two parallel rows on either side of the side seam. Allow the glue to dry completely. Repeat this process on all sides (Use three rows of glass on the back).
7. Insert a light kit into the hole and your new light is complete.
8. Just for fun, place nightlight into a terracotta pot.
